Pastor Miquel has taken the helm for the mission work in Aguilar. The work presently has 19 faithful adults and children from four families. Several of



the men from our church make the two 140 mile roundtrip every other Sunday in our old church van to pick them up. The other Sunday Pastor Miguel presides in one of the families' apartment as they watch our services by YouTube. On Wednesday nights, Pastor Miguel teaches a discipleship class. Last week, he led Sebastian to the Lord who is an 18 year-old friend of one of these families. Please continue to pray for Pastor Miguel as he labors in the Aguilar de Campoo Faith Baptist Mission.
