ACK HOME IN SPAIN AFTER OUR MINI-FURLOUGH

Therese and I returned back to Spain a week ago after having spent almost three months in the USA on furlough. As we mentioned in our January/February prayer letter, besides visiting some of our supporting churches in Texas, one of the purposes of our furlough was to try to determine the Lord's will for our future ministry. I will write about that below. But another reason for our visit was to attend to some health problems that both of us are having, primarily due to getting up there in years. Nevertheless, I, Bill, did not expect that it would involve surgery to correct a faulty operation and follow-up treatment that was performed here in Spain last summer! Thankfully, the Lord directed us to a urologist surgeon who not only diagnosed my physical problem and corrected it with surgery; but another great blessing was that every time we met he called me "brother"! And correctly so, for Dr. Nelson of Denton, Texas is a brother in Christ. He also has served as a medical missionary in El Salvador so we could also converse in Spanish! Thank the Lord that He used Dr. Nelson to diagnose and correct in just a few weeks a 9 year physical problem that I had been suffering with. Please continue to pray for me and Therese in our other health ailments that they might not prevent us from fully serving the Lord!

So having arrived back in Palencia, Spain, we found the church doing great in our absence. Pastor Valentin continues to lead the church on to greater heights. Although Satan has caused a couple of our folks to backslide, there are new people who have started attending and are in need of salvation. I preached in this past Sunday AM service on John 14:6. Three men raised their hands at the invitation for prayer for salvation. I have already talked to one of

them, Nelson, who made a profession of faith. Pray that we might have an opportunity to further talk with Nelson as well as the other two men who raised their hands for salvation.

Nelson is one of the men of the new mission in Aguilar de Campoo. Pastor Miguel is continuing to serve there and doing a great job. Therese and I drove the 70 miles to Aguilar last night to attend to a home Bible study in the home of one of the families. A new couple attended the study last night and had never heard of the message of salvation. *Pray for Luis and Ana* that Pastor Miguel might also have an opportunity to further witness to them.
